Below are some bullet points of helpful information for our neighborhood included in the Acorn released quarterly.

- <u>Firearms:</u> No firearms may be discharged in our community per our POA Restrictions
- Tree and Brush Trimming: Property owners please are mindful of trimming that needs to be done on your property to maintain visibility on street corners. Please adhere to commonly established practices of trimming oaks in a proper manner and at an appropriate time of year to avoid conveyance of Oak Wilt disease which decimates entire forests. If there is any question about whether trees and brush are on county maintained property please call the county office of Lon Shell 512-847-3149 or email lon.shell@co.hays.tx.us
- <u>Pets:</u> Per Hays County Ordinance all Pets must be either on leashes or confined to your property. If you see animals running loose, you can post a message to our River Oaks Google Group or Call WAG Rescue at 512-847-3200. If you've lost a pet, try posting a message on Google Groups; there usually is a response.
- Speed Control: Drive Safely, the River Oaks speed limit is 25 MPH

Use this email address for any communications to the board except for Architectural review maters.
